Ohio Wesleyan Outcomes

A Follow-up Study of the Class of 2000 September, 2001

This summer Career Services conducted a survey, which will be repeated annually, to study the career journeys of Ohio Wesleyan graduates. Questionnaires were sent out to Ohio Wesleyan University graduates approximately one year after their graduation. The initial mailing included a paper copy of the survey with a postage-paid return envelope. A follow-up reminder postcard was sent to individuals who had not returned the survey, informing them of the option of filling out the survey on-line. These two mailings yielded a return rate of 34% of the Class of 2000.

- Summary Statistics
- Employment Information
- Graduate School Information

I hope this report will serve as a reference guide for all faculty, staff, students, parents, and alumni interested in career-related statistics for recent Ohio Wesleyan graduates.

Ohio Wesleyan's Class of 2000 graduates are successfully employed in a variety of employment areas. Of the employed respondents, 88% of those employed full-time and 100% of those employed part-time reported that they were working in their field of choice. Additionally, many graduates chose to pursue graduate studies in a diverse array of programs. The current status of the Class of 2000 is as follows:

65% are currently employed
20% are enrolled in graduate school
14% are enrolled in graduate school and employed
1% are involved in other endeavors or were not employed at the time of the survey





CURRENT STATUS: CLASS OF 2000




STUDY OF THE CLASS OF 2000 GRADUATES EMPLOYED FULL-TIME




Starting Salaries - Full-Time Employment




Cumulative Percentage of Respondents Employed Over Time
