How and Why to Enable 2-Step Verification?

Most people only protect their accounts with a password. However, with 2-Step Verification, you'll protect your account with your password and your phone. If anyone manages to steal or guess your password, they'll also need to have your phone to get into your account.

We have 2-Step Verification enabled on OWU BishopApps, our Google G Suite for Education domain, to provide additional protection.

It is recommended that you enable it on your account, which consists of receiving a text message with a code or responding to a prompt to access your account on a new computer/device. You'll only need the second step every 30 days on devices that you trust. It's easily enabled or removed, and there are a few options for the second step.

HOW IT WORKS:

OWU employees are able to purchase discounted blocks of meals to be used at the Faculty-Staff Dining Room or AVI's anytime dining locations (Smith Dining Hall and Hamilton-Williams Marketplace).

You also can add debit dollars to your account to buy individual meals at the anytime dining options or other on-campus venues, including Faculty-Staff Dining Room, Merrick Café, Bishop Café, and the T-Store.

Any balances on your individual employee cards or departmental cards will carry over.

The door price for lunch in the FSDR is \$7.50, and is an all-inclusive price that includes the soup and salad bar, hot entrée selections with accompaniments and desserts. Soup/salad will no longer be sold separately. Payment forms include Block Plan Meal Swipe (one swipe is one entry), Dining Dollars, Cash or Credit. As in the past, students may join a faculty or staff member as a guest.

You are able to reload your ID card with a Block Plan or Dining Dollars at any time using the Get website: **get.cbord.com/owu**

On the website, enter your OWU credentials and it will direct you to a page to load Block Plan Meal Swipes or Dining Dollars with a credit card.
