The Conductors



John Locke served on the UNC Greensboro School of Music Faculty as Director of Bands, Director of Summer Music Camps, conductor of the Wind Ensemble, and conducting teacher from 1982 until his retirement in December, 2018. Previously, Dr. Locke held teaching positions in music at West Virginia University, Southeast Missouri State University, and the University of Illinois. He has conducted band performances throughout the world including National Conventions of the MENC, CBDNA, ABA, the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C., Lincoln Center in New York City, Dvorak Hall in Prague, Czech Republic, Innsbruck, Austria, Bologna and Rome, Italy. Under Locke's leadership, the UNCG Wind Ensemble released 21 commercially available compact discs including *fireworks!* which was a Grammy Entry List 2011 CD in two categories, "Classical Album of the Year" and "Best Orchestral Performance." He has guest conducted the U.S. Air Force Band, U.S. Army Field Band, U.S. Navy Band, "The President's Own" U.S. Marine Band, the Dallas Wind Symphony, as well as numerous university bands, all-state honor bands, and intercollegiate bands.



Richard Edwards is Professor of Music Education and Director of Bands at Ohio Wesleyan University. He serves as coordinator of the music education program, conductor of the OWU Symphonic Wind Ensemble and The Marching Bishops, and director of several community arts events including the OWU Summer Music Camp, the OWU Masterclass Marching Band Festival, and the OWU Music Festival. His doctoral dissertation created the Musical Brain Imaging Research Database (MusicBIRD), a comprehensive review of all brain imaging studies through 2006 involving human music activity to identify neuroscience research implications for music learning. Previously, Dr. Edwards taught high school band and elementary general music in Ohio and North Carolina, directed college bands at UNC Greensboro and Ithaca College, and served as the field commander for the Ohio University Marching 110.



Melisa Grimes is director of bands at Olentangy Shanahan Middle School and assistant band director of the Olentangy High School Marching Band. Melissa has been Pit Orchestra director for Olentangy Orange High School's Orangelight Productions *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown*, *Seussical: The Musical*, *Little Shop of Horrors*, and *Heathers: The Musical*. She earned her Bachelor of Music Education Magna Cum Laude from Otterbein University in 2014 and her Master of Music Education from Vandercook College of Music in Chicago, Illinois in 2020. Melissa's master thesis was developing curriculum to motivate beginning band students to practice at home by teaching their parents to play their band instruments in five introductory instrument lessons.



Libby Hainrihar is active as a choral conductor, adjudicator, clinician and accompanist throughout the state of Ohio. Prior to completing her doctoral studies in choral conducting at Ohio State University, Mrs. Hainrihar was Director of Vocal Music at Marysville High School, where she directed the Symphonic Choir, Women's Select, and A Cappella Choirs, and taught Music Theory classes. She earned her BM in Music Education at Bowling Green State University and MM in Conducting at Kent State University. She currently serves as Membership Chair for the Ohio Choral Directors Association.



Hilary Apfelstadt is Professor Emerita of Choral Studies at the University of Toronto where she held the Elmer Iseler Chair in Conducting, and won the inaugural Teaching Excellence Award in the Faculty of Music. Previously she taught at the Ohio State University (1993 - 2010) and UNC Greensboro for ten years. Her teaching experiences range from public school to community ensembles to church choirs, including fourteen years as Director of Music at Linworth UMC in Columbus. She has led her university choirs at professional conferences of OMEA, ACDA, and Choral Canada, and guest conducted throughout North America and Europe, including concerts with the National Youth Choir of Canada and more than 35 U.S. All-State choruses. She is a prolific author and clinician, and often does masterclasses and residencies with various choral ensembles. A Life Member of ACDA, Hilary Apfelstadt was National President from 2007 - 2009 and recently served as Interim Executive Director (2020 - 2021). She has been honored with leadership awards from the Ohio Choral Directors Association, NC-ACDA, Central Region ACDA, and Choirs Ontario.
