It may also emphasize reading in an area of economics that is new to the student and in which there is no formal course at Ohio Wesleyan University. No paper is required, but the reading list must be approved in advance by the directing faculty member. Also, it may require an essay on the topic to be written at the end of the term or another significant evaluative instrument.

Normally, the reading will include journal articles, government documents and books not used in regular courses. This option is of greater value to a student preparing for graduate school in economics or some interdisciplinary field.

To be accepted in a Directed Readings, a student must have a 3.0 overall grade point average. Also, the student should have completed most of his or her major. The student must be prepared to meet with the supervising faculty member at least once a week and must show progress at each meeting. Finally, the list of readings must be approved prior to the end of the registration period in order for the Directed Readings to be approved.
