EARLY DECISION AGREEMENT FORM

The National Association of College Admission Counselors (NACAC) defines Early Decision as "the term used to describe the application process in which a commitment is made by the student to the institution, that, if admitted, the student will enroll. Only a student who can make a deliberate and well-reasoned first choice decision should apply under an Early Decision plan because the institution will require a nonrefundable deposit before January 4.
