For many years, John Peckinpaugh has served Ohio Wesleyan as volunteer in a wide variety of significant ways.

Over two decades, he has been a faithful worker on behalf of the annual fund. During a term as Century Club President, he personally signed over 4,000 letters to Century Club prospects.
